

## **MHASC Covid-19 Rules** (updated 7 October, 2021)

As expected, the NSW COVID vaccination rate has reached 70% and 'stay-at-home' orders for 'fully vaccinated' adults will change from next Monday, 11 October.

From Monday 11 October those members who are 'fully vaccinated' can attend the club (without 5km/LGA restriction).

Rules to be observed;

- 'Indoors' the 4sqm rule applies. This means that at any time there may be no more than;
  - 15 people inside the 'Dinghy Storage' space.
  - 6 people in the 'Kitchen/Briefing room' space.
  - 4 people in the 'Men's changeroom/toilets' space (including 1 only in the shower).
  - 2 people in the 'Ladies changeroom/toilet' space (including 1 in the shower).
  - 12 people socialising on the deck.
- 'Outdoors' up to 30 people can gather; up to 30 boats can be in the rigging/park area and/or in proximity on the water.
- If the number of people indoors, on the deck, in the changerooms, or rigging boats exceeds the limits then you need to wait your turn.
- You must be able to show your proof of vaccination at all times.

For those who are NOT fully vaccinated you may only attend the club if you live within 5km of the club. You need to continue to operate on the 'Get In, Sail, Get Out' basis;

- You may only enter the club to retrieve and return your boat.
- You may not enter the club or rig your boat if that would result in more than two boats in the rigging area.

If you have a 'medical exemption' for vaccination you must advise Chris or Graham before attending the Club.

Everyone is reminded:

- NOT to attend the club if you are; (a) close contact, (b) have symptoms, (c) awaiting a test result.
- You must wear a mask inside the clubhouse.
- Of sensible physical distancing.
- You must send Chris ([kelleway@bigpond.com](mailto:kelleway@bigpond.com)) or Graham ([jenningsgraham1@gmail.com](mailto:jenningsgraham1@gmail.com)) an email before attending the Club advising your

planned times of arrival and departure. By sending your email you are confirming that you are complying with the Club's Covid Rules requirements.

As the club will not be officially open, and we have no staff on-site we ask all people to self-enforce these rules.

Please note, 'Community Sport' will not be allowed until the NSW vaccination rate reaches 80%. The specific rules for 'Community Sport' and 'Sailing' will then be released. No organised racing can occur until that time.

An updated 'Racing Calendar' and short term 'Duty Roster' will be published shortly in anticipation of season commencement on Sunday, 31 October.

The Government announced that restrictions will be relaxed from 1 December for those who are not fully vaccinated.

We can't wait to be racing again and look forward to seeing you at the Club soon.
