By signing this application I confirm that if accepted to participate that;

- I agree that participation in MHASC ‘Learn to Race’ is entirely at my own risk. I will not hold the Club or its officers liable for any injury to persons, or damage to equipment, in the event of a mishap on the water, or on the Club's premises.
  - I acknowledge that insurance for person & property is my own responsibility, & that the Club's insurance does not cover my participation in Club activities.

- I acknowledge that Personal Injury Insurance cover is my responsibility (Australian Sailing provide automatic cover to financial members and MHASC is an Affiliated Club, link here; [Personal Accident Insurance](#) ).
- I acknowledge that if I am using my own Laser that at all times I will have 'Off the Beach' Dinghy Insurance cover with 3rd Party liability insurance of at least \$10 million, and I understand that the Club strongly recommends that I have comprehensive insurance. I will or have provided the Club with details of my 'Off the Beach' Dinghy insurances.
- I acknowledge the risks inherent in Laser sailing, & that the Club does not & cannot provide rescue facilities for all contingencies. Consistent with Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) Rule 4 Decision to Race: The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in 'Learn to Race', or to continue in a 'Learn to Race' sailing session, is hers alone.
- I undertake to compete in accordance with the Racing Rules of Sailing, Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 for 'Off the Beach Boats', and the by-laws of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA). Accordingly, I undertake to;
  - Always wear an approved PFD 2 (EN393-50N) when sailing a Laser.
  - Ensure restraining fittings are used for my mast, centreboard and rudder at all times.
  - Ensure the condition of my boat is fair and reasonable to minimise the rescue need for gear failure and for my own safety.
- I agree that my email address may be used for communication on Club & sailing matters, and may be available to other members for these purposes.  
I will not use or disclose the email address of other Club members for communication on other matters without the agreement of that member.
- I will not operate the davit crane without authorisation from the Committee.
